About the presenter: Detective Chad Albin has been a Police Officer in Lee's Summit for 19 years, assigned to the Criminal Investigations Unit for the past 12 years. His primary assignment for the LSPD is to investigate crimes related to sex offense and crimes involving digital evidence (ex. Internet base crimes, mobile phones, computer, etc). Det Albin currently represents LSPD on the United States Secret Service Electronic Crimes Task Force (USSS ECTF).
